- Si recibe una exención de cuotas, tiene que informar a la corte si hay algún cambio en la situación económica de usted, o de su dependiente o pupilo. Tiene que informar a la corte dentro de cinco días si mejoran las finanzas de usted, su dependiente o pupilo o si está en condiciones de pagar las cuotas o costos del caso. (Presente a la corte el Notice to Court of Improved Financial Situation or Settlement [Aviso a la corte de mejor situación económica o resolución del caso] [formulario FW-010] o el Notice to Court of Improved Financial Situation or Settlement [Ward or Conservatee] [Aviso a la corte de mejor situación económica o resolución del caso] [dependiente o pupilo] [formulario FW-010-GC].). Es posible que usted, su dependiente o pupilo tenga que reembolsar todos los montos eximidos después de haber perdido su elegibilidad.
- Si recibe un fallo u orden de manutención en un caso de derecho familiar: Si la corte determina que sus circunstancias han cambiado y ahora puede pagar, le puede ordenar que pague las cuotas y costos eximidos, en todo o en parte. Si la corte toma esta decisión, tendrá la oportunidad de solicitar una audiencia.
- Si gana su caso en la corte de primera instancia: En la mayoría de los casos, se ordenará a la otra parte que pague las cuotas y costos de la corte que le eximieron. La corte no publicará una satisfacción del fallo hasta que se hayan pagado esas cuotas y costos. (Esto no se aplica en casos de retención ilícita. La solicitud de despido del caso (formulario CIV-110) tiene que incluir una declaración jurada bajo pena de perjurio que las cuotas y costos de la corte fueron pagados. En los casos de derecho familiar se aplican reglas especiales.
- La corte puede iniciar un proceso de cobranza de las cuotas y costos adeudados. Si la corte de primera instancia ordena que se le paguen las cuotas y costos eximidos, podrá iniciar procesos de cobranza y agregar una multa de \$25 más todos los costos de cobranza.
- Si está en la cárcel o en una prisión del estado: Es posible que los prisioneros tengan que pagar el costo total de las cuotas de presentación ante la corte de primera instancia, pero pueden hacer el pago a plazos. Vea la sección 68635 del Código de Gobierno.
- Si desea que se creen actas de su audiencia o juicio: Existen distintos motivos por el cual usted desee actas de la audiencia o el juicio. Entre ellos, es posible que quiera las actas en una apelación si no está de acuerdo con una orden de la corte o un fallo. Si recibe una exención de cuotas y si la corte no está grabando de manera electrónica el proceso, puede solicitar que un taquígrafo oficial asista a la audiencia o al juicio sin costo para que haya actas del proceso. Debe usar el formulario FW-020 para hacer esta solicitud, la cual debe presentar al menos 10 días calendario antes de la fecha programada de la audiencia o lo antes posible si la fecha de audiencia está programada con un aviso menor a 10 días.

Si desea una transcripción por escrito después de la audiencia o el juicio, necesitará pagar por separado al taquígrafo o planear otra manera para obtener la transcripción. Warnings and Notices to the Restrained Person in 2

You Cannot Have Firearms (Guns), Firearm Parts, or Ammunition

You cannot own, have, possess, buy or try to buy, receive or try to receive, or otherwise get any prohibited items listed in item 7b on page 3 while this Order is in effect. If you do, you can go to jail and pay a \$1,000 fine. You must sell to or store with a licensed gun dealer, or turn in to a law enforcement agency, any firearms (guns) and firearm parts that you have or control as stated in item 7 above. The court will require you to prove that you did so.

Notice Regarding Nonappearance at Hearing and Service of Order

If you have been personally served with this Temporary Restraining Order and form CH-109, *Notice of Court Hearing*, but you do not appear at the hearing either in person or by a lawyer, and a restraining order that is the same as this Temporary Restraining Order except for the expiration date is issued at the hearing, a copy of the order will be served on you by mail at the address in item (2).

If this address is not correct or you wish to verify that the Temporary Restraining Order was converted into a restraining order at the hearing without substantive change, or to find out the duration of the order, contact the clerk of the court.

After You Have Been Served With a Restraining Order

- Obey all the orders.
- Read form CH-120-INFO, How Can I Respond to a Request for Civil Harassment Restraining Orders?, to learn how to respond to this Order.
- If you want to respond, fill out form CH-120, Response to Request for Civil Harassment Restraining Orders, and file it with the court clerk. You do not have to pay any fee to file your response if the Request claims that you inflicted or threatened violence against or stalked the person in 1.

Case Number:		

- You must have form CH-120 served by mail on the person in ① or that person's attorney. You cannot do this yourself. The person who does the mailing should complete and sign form CH-250, *Proof of Service by Mail*. File the completed proof of service with the court clerk before the hearing date or bring it with you to the hearing.
- In addition to the response, you may file and have declarations served, signed by you and other persons who have personal knowledge of the facts. You may use form MC-030, *Declaration*, for this purpose. It is available from the clerk's office at the court shown on page 1 of this form or at www.courts.ca.gov/forms. If you do not know how to prepare a declaration, you should see a lawyer.
- Whether or not you file a response, you should attend the hearing. If you have any witnesses, they must also go to the hearing.
- At the hearing, the judge can make restraining orders against you that last for up to five years. Tell the judge why you disagree with the orders requested.

Instructions for Law Enforcement

Enforcing the Restraining Order

This order is enforceable by any law enforcement agency that has received the order, is shown a copy of the order, or has verified its existence on the California Restraining and Protective Orders System (CARPOS). If the law enforcement agency has not received proof of service on the restrained person, the agency must advise the restrained person of the terms of the order and then must enforce it. Violations of this order are subject to criminal penalties.

Start Date and End Date of Orders

This order *starts* on the date next to the judge's signature on page 4. The order *ends* on the expiration date in item 4 on page 1.

Arrest Required if Order Is Violated

If an officer has probable cause to believe that the restrained person had notice of the order and has disobeyed the order, the officer must arrest the restrained person. (Pen. Code, §§ 836(c)(1), 13701(b).) A violation of the order may be a violation of Penal Code section 166 or 273.6. Agencies are encouraged to enter violation messages into CARPOS.

Notice/Proof of Service

The law enforcement agency must first determine if the restrained person had notice of the order. Consider the restrained person "served" (given notice) if (Pen. Code, § 836(c)(2)):

- The officer sees a copy of the Proof of Service or confirms that the Proof of Service is on file; or
- The restrained person was informed of the order by an officer.

An officer can obtain information about the contents of the order and proof of service in CARPOS. If proof of service on the restrained person cannot be verified, the agency must advise the restrained person of the terms of the order and then enforce it.



Case Number:	

If the Protected Person Contacts the Restrained Person

Even if the protected person invites or consents to contact with the restrained person, this order remains in effect and must be enforced. The protected person cannot be arrested for inviting or consenting to contact with the restrained person. The order can be changed only by another court order. (Pen. Code, § 13710(b).)

Conflicting Orders—Priorities for Enforcement

If more than one restraining order has been issued protecting the protected person from the restrained person, the orders must be enforced in the following priority (see Pen. Code, § 136.2 and Fam. Code, § 6383(h)(2), 6405(b)):

- 1. Emergency Protective Order (EPO): If one of the orders is an Emergency Protective Order (form EPO-001), provisions (e.g., stay-away order) that are more restrictive than in the other restraining/protective orders must be enforced. Provisions of another order that do not conflict with the EPO must be enforced.
- 2. No-Contact Order: If a restraining/protective order includes a no-contact order, the no-contact order must be enforced. Item 5a(2) is an example of a no-contact order.
- 3. Criminal Protective Order (CPO). If none of the orders include an EPO or a no-contact order, the most recent CPO must be enforced. (Fam. Code, §§ 6383(h)(2) and 6405(b).) Additionally, a CPO issued in a criminal case involving charges of domestic violence, Penal Code sections 261, 261.5, or former 262, or charges requiring sex offender registration must be enforced over any civil court order. (Pen. Code, § 136.2(e)(2).) All provisions in the civil court order that do not conflict with the CPO must be enforced.
- 4. Civil Restraining Orders: If there is more than one civil restraining order (e.g., domestic violence, juvenile, elder abuse, civil harassment), then the order that was issued last must be enforced. Provisions that do not conflict with the most recent civil restraining order must be enforced.

¿Qué es la "Prueba de entrega en persona"?

¿Qué es la "entrega legal"?

La entrega legal es el acto de entregar sus documentos legales a la otra parte. Hay muchos tipos de entrega legal: en persona, por correo y otros. Este formulario trata sobre la entrega legal personal o "en persona". La Solicitud de órdenes de restricción por acoso civil (formulario CH-100), el Aviso de audiencia en la corte (formulario CH-109) y la Orden de restricción temporal (formulario CH-110) se tienen que entregar "en persona". Esto quiere decir que alguien le tiene que entregar en mano una copia de los formularios a la persona a restringir. Estos formularios no se pueden entregar por correo.

La entrega legal le informa a la otra persona:

- Qué órdenes está solicitando
- · La fecha de audiencia
- · Cómo responder

¿Por qué tengo que hacer la entrega legal de las órdenes?

- La policía no puede arrestar a nadie por violar una orden a menos que la persona restringida sepa sobre la orden.
- El juez no puede dictar órdenes permanentes a menos que se haga la entrega legal a la persona restringida.



¡No haga la entrega por correo!

¿Quién puede hacer la entrega legal?

Pídale a alguien que conozca, a un profesional de entrega legal o a una agencia del orden público que entregue personalmente una copia de los formularios a la persona que va a ser restringida. **No le puede** enviar los formularios a esa persona por correo.

La persona que entrega la orden tiene que:

- · Tener al menos 18 años de edad
- No ser usted ni ninguna de las personas a ser protegidas por las órdenes

El alguacil o alguacil de paz puede tener autorización para hacer la entrega legal de las órdenes de la corte **sin cargo**, si las órdenes se deben a alegatos de acecho, violencia ilegítima o amenaza plausible de violencia, o si tiene derecho a una exención de cuotas.

Un "profesional de entrega legal registrado" es una empresa a la que paga para entregar los formularios de la corte. Busque "Process Serving" (Entrega legal) en las Páginas Amarillas o Internet.

(Si una agencia del orden público o el profesional de entrega legal usa un formulario distinto de Prueba de entrega, verifique que indique los formularios que fueron entregados.)

Cómo hacer la entrega legal

Pídale a la persona que hace la entrega que:

- Se acerque a la persona a quien tiene que hacer la entrega.
- Verifique que se trate de la persona correcta. Pregunte a la persona cómo se llama.
- Le dé a la persona copias de todos los documentos indicados en el formulario CH-200, Prueba de entrega en persona.
- Llene y firme el formulario de Prueba de entrega en persona.
- Le dé a usted la Prueba de entrega en persona firmada.

¿Qué se hace si la otra persona no quiere tomar los documentos o los rompe?

- Si la persona no quiere tomar los documentos, simplemente déjelos cerca suyo.
- No importa si la persona los rompe. La entrega se considera completada.



¿Qué es la "Prueba de entrega en persona"?

¿Cuándo se tienen que entregar las órdenes?

Depende. Para saber la fecha exacta, tiene que fijarse en dos cosas en el formulario CH-109, Aviso de audiencia en la corte:

Primero, fijese en la fecha de audiencia en la página 1 del formulario CH-109.



Vea un calendario. Reste de la fecha de la audiencia el número de días en (5). Esa es la fecha límite para entregar las órdenes. Siempre está bien entregarlas antes de esa fecha.

Si no hay nada marcado ni escrito en (5), debe hacer la entrega legal de las órdenes por lo menos cinco días antes de la audiencia.

¿Quién firma la Prueba de entrega en persona?

Solo la persona que hace la entrega de las órdenes puede firmar el formulario CH-200, *Prueba de entrega en persona*. No tiene que firmarla usted. La persona a ser restringida no tiene que firmarla tampoco.

¿Qué hago con la Prueba de entrega en persona llenada?

Si las órdenes fueron entregadas por otra persona que no sea el alguacil, deberá:

- · Hacer varias copias.
- Presentar el original en la corte antes de su audiencia.
- Pedirle al secretario de la corte que la ingrese en el Sistema de Telecomunicaciones de Agencias del Orden Público de California (CLETS), un sistema informático especial que le informa a la policía en todo el estado sobre las órdenes que lo protegen.
- Si el secretario le dice que la corte no puede ingresar las órdenes en la computadora, lleve una copia de la *Orden de restricción temporal* (formulario CH-110) y de la *Prueba de entrega en persona* (formulario CH-200) a su comisaría local. Allí registrarán la información en el sistema informático estatal. De esa manera, la policía de todo el estado sabrá que hizo la entrega legal de su orden de restricción.
- Llevar una copia de la Prueba de entrega en persona completada a su audiencia.
- Tener siempre una copia adicional de las órdenes de restricción consigo para su seguridad.

Si sus documentos fueron entregados por un alguacil, éste enviará la prueba de entrega a la corte y a CLETS en su nombre.

¿Qué pasa si no puedo hacer la entrega legal de las órdenes antes de la fecha de audiencia?

Antes de la audiencia, llene y presente el formulario CH-115, Solicitud para aplazar audiencia de corte y volver a emitir orden de restricción temporal. Este formulario le pide a la corte una nueva fecha de audiencia y extiende la vigencia de las órdenes hasta esa fecha. Pídale al secretario un formulario. Después de que la corte haya vuelto a emitir las órdenes, adjunte una copia del formulario CH-116, Aviso de nueva fecha de audiencia y orden sobre la reemisión, a una copia de sus órdenes originales. Pídale al secretario que ingrese el formulario CH-116 en CLETS, o el secretario puede pedirle a usted o a su abogado que entregue una copia a la policía. De esa manera, la policía sabrá que sus órdenes siguen en vigencia.
