Following the hearings, the court held its first Adoption Day celebration, bringing together families, court staff, and community organizations to recognize the significance of each adoption.

Margaret Jones-Ryan, Chief Resource Officer, introduced the court's new adoption tree and welcomed families who finalized adoptions at the Superior Court of San Benito County to write their first names and adoption year on leaf-shaped stickers and place them on the wall, building a tree that serves as a reminder of every adoption journey.
