## Tentative Decisions for September 28, 2026

**Courtroom #1: Judge J. Omar Rodriguez**

**PR-18-00065      In re the Estate of: Jahn, Mark Allen**

The Petition for Final Distribution is APPROVED as requested. Notice has been given as required by law.

Administration of Estates Act. Petitioner is to file an Inventory and Appraisal within four months of issuance of letters (Prob. Code section 8800(b)) and either a petition for an order for final distribution of the estate or a report of status of administration within the timeframe set out in Probate Code section 12200.

The matter is set for hearing on April 12, 2027, at 10:00 a.m. for status of estate or final account and distribution. No appearances at the hearing will be required if the court determines that administration of the estate is timely proceeding, or good cause is shown why more time is required.

**PR-26-00069                      In the Matter of Maximiliano Damien Ramirez**

Based on the Investigator's Report filed September 23, 2026, the hearing is continued to February 22, 2027 at 10:00 a.m. to allow the regional center time to determine the proposed conservatee's eligibility and to complete a written assessment in compliance with Probate Code Section 1827 .5. The temporary conservatorship be extended to the continued hearing date. No appearances are necessary on September 28, 2026.
