FL-22-00215 Youmans, Emily M. vs. Youmans, Stephen N.

The hearing on Respondent's Request for Order regarding child support, filed February 24, 2026, is continued to April 30, 2026, at 1:30 a.m. in Department 2 as the Department of Child Support Services is involved in the matter and the request pertains to child support costs.

FL-22-00277 Hughbanks, Danae vs. Torres, Timothy

Petitioner's Request for Order waiving Respondent's Preliminary Financial Disclosure is GRANTED.

FL-23-00086 Del Carlo, Lucille vs. Del Carlo, Frank

The hearings on calendar for March 11, 2026 are continued to March 24, 2026 at 8:30 a.m. to be heard with the trial setting on the competing domestic violence restraining order petitions.

FL-24-00024 Reynoso, Elsa vs. Flores, Fernando

Petitioner's February 4, 2026 Request for Order ("Request) is GRANTED. Respondent is ordered to sign and provide Petitioner with a copy of the signed orders which were attached as Exhibit B to the Request within 10 days after service of the order after hearing and reimburse Petitioner \$550 in the preparation of the QDRO cost within the same timeframe. The Court issues the Income and Withholding Order for child support, which was attached as Exhibit C to the Request. The request for reimbursement is denied without prejudice as Petitioner has not presented evidence that \$800 in costs were incurred.

FL-24-00099 Lopez, Lela Marie vs. Lopez, Richard Joseph

The matter is continued to May 6, 2026 at 8:30 a.m. On December 3, 2025, this hearing was scheduled and the Court was to provide notice. The March 11th hearing was not noticed, so the matter has to be continued. The Court to provide notice of the Mary 6, 2026 hearing date.

FL-25-00089 Betancourt, Mirzha vs. Vallejo, Jose

Petitioner's August 13, 2025 Request for Order as it pertains to child support is GRANTED.

Respondent is ordered to pay child support in the amount of \$398.00 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. Arrears are payable at a rate of \$50 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. Each party must pay 50% of child-care costs related to employment or reasonably necessary job training. Each party must pay 50% reasonable uninsured health-care costs for the children. The court used a printout of a computer calculation and findings, which is located below and incorporated in this order.
