## Amended Tentative Decisions for March 4 2026

**Courtroom #1: Judge J. Omar Rodriguez**

**FL-20-00143          Yebra, Cathy vs. Gutierrez, Christian**

Petitioner's October 31, 2025, Request for Order regarding child custody, visitation and child support is DENIED without prejudice as Petitioner has failed to properly and timely serve Respondent with the moving papers and failed to attend mediation.

**FL-23-00249          Tran, Jenny My Phuong vs. Tran, Duynam**

Petitioner's Request for Order waiving Respondent's Preliminary Financial Disclosure is GRANTED.

**FL-25-00084          Lorenzo, Gabriel vs. Cortez-Santos, Carmen**

Respondent's August 1, 2025 Request for Order regarding child and spousal support is GRANTED.

Petitioner is ordered to pay child support in the amount of \$697.00 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. Arrears are payable at a rate of \$50 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. Each party must pay 50% of child-care costs related to employment or reasonably necessary job training. Each party must pay 50% reasonable uninsured health-care costs for the children. The court used a printout of a computer calculation and findings, which is located below and incorporated in this order.

Petitioner is ordered to pay spousal support in the amount of \$559.00 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. Arrears are payable at a rate of \$50 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. The court used a printout of a computer calculation and findings, which is located below and incorporated in this order.

The Court notes that the parties reached a full agreement at mediation regarding custody and visitation. That order remains in effect without modification. Attorney LaForge shall prepare the Order After Hearing.

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**FL-25-00212                      Herrera, Ana Patricia vs. Gonzalez Brizuela, Daniel**

Respondent's December 24, 2025 Request for Order is DENIED. The parties were in Court on December 10, 2025 and Judge Johnson made orders regarding child support and spousal support. Judge Johnson also addressed custody and visitation, despite the fact that the parties reached a full mediation agreement, which was signed on November 21, 2025. The signed mediation agreement, included a provision regarding holiday visitation, and was not contingent on the parties' respective living arrangements.

As to the motion for reconsideration, Code of Civil Procedure section 1008 requires a statement of new or different facts or circumstances that were not known to the party at the time the order was made. Here, Respondent merely attempts to relitigate the orders previously made stating that Petitioner understates her income and that Respondent's calculated income is not accurate. As a result, Respondent has failed to comply with section 1008.

Petitioner's November 4, 2025, Request for Order regarding child custody and property control support is DENIED without prejudice as Petitioner has failed to properly and timely serve Respondent with the moving papers and failed to attend mediation.
