FL-21-00084 Arango v. Arango-Martinez

Respondent's Request for Order for Child Support is GRANTED. Petitioner is ordered to pay child support at \$4 per month, which is due on the first of each month. The orders are effective on May 1, 2025. Each party must pay 50% of child-care costs related to employment or reasonably necessary job training. Each party must pay 50% reasonable uninsured health-care costs for the children. The court used a printout of a computer calculation and findings, which is located below and incorporated in this order.

FL-22-00026 Atkins v. Atkins

Respondent's Request for Child Support is DENIED. This Court does not have jurisdiction to make orders because the Department of Child Support Services is enforcing child support.

Respondent's Request for Order regarding Spousal Support is DENIED. The parties entered into a settlement agreement and Judgment was entered on September 29, 2023. Section 4.1 of the Judgement states, "Husband shall pay to Wife \$3,100 each month in **non-modifiable** spousal support beginning October 1, 2023 through October 31, 2035 (for a period of 12 years)...Support shall only terminate upon 1) the death of either party or 2) remarriage of Wife, otherwise the amount and duration shall be non-modifiable." (Judgment Section 4.1, emphasis added.) Respondent does not allege that either party has died or that Petitioner-wife has remarried. As a result, the Request for Order is DENIED.

FL-25-00024 Minelli v. Minelli

Respondent's Request for Order for Spousal Support is GRANTED. Spousal support is set at \$2,071 per month. One-half of the payment is due on the first of each month and one-half of the payment is due on the fifteenth of each month. The orders are effective on May 1, 2025 and shall terminate after Petitioner has made a total of 16 months' worth of spousal support payments.

The court used a printout of a computer calculation and findings, which is located below and incorporated in this order. The data used for the guideline calculation was taken from the parties' respective Income and Expense Declarations filed with the court.

Respondent's Request that each party be responsible for one-half of all uncovered prenatal medical costs after the parties exchange receipts according to law is GRANTED. Petitioner shall pay Respondent one-half of all uncovered medical costs within 30 days after receiving a receipt of costs.
