FL-23-00053 Bassi, Alejandro vs. Falahat, Elle

Petitioner's Request for Order Voluntary Waiver of Preliminary Disclosure per Family Code Section 2017 (b) is GRANTED as requested. The Self-Help Center shall prepare the order after hearing.

FL-24-00041 Fairbanks, Craig vs. Fairbanks, Kristine Elise

Petitioner's Request for Order Voluntary Waiver of Preliminary Disclosure per Family Code Section 2017 (b) is GRANTED as requested. The Self-Help Center shall prepare the order after hearing.

FL-24-00144 Damon, Lyndsie Marie vs. Reyes, Francisco

In light of Petitioner's Request for Order, which was filed on September 4, 2025, regarding child support and other orders, the hearing on Respondent's July 22, 2025 Request for Order is continued to October 8, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. so that both requests can be heard together.

FL-24-00211 Castaneda, Richard vs. Castaneda, Natasha

Respondent's Request for Order is GRANTED in part. The Court has the authority under Family Code section 290 and Code of Civil Procedure section 128 to issue orders necessary to enforce its prior judgment. Respondent's Request for the appointment of elisor is GRANTED. The Clerk of the Court is appointed as elisor. Following payment of \$117,618 reimbursement to Respondent, the remaining proceeds of the sale of the residence shall be held into Respondent's trust account pending agreement of the parties or further order.

The Court will reserve jurisdiction regarding the request to order Petitioner to vacate the residence.

Respondent's evidentiary objections as to Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, H and I are sustained. Objections to Exhibits F, G are overruled.

FL-24-00222 Torres, Anthony Angel vs. Cervantes, Yadira

Petitioner's Request for Order Voluntary Waiver of Preliminary Disclosure per Family Code Section 2017 (b) is DENIED without prejudice as the Petitioner failed to file a proof of service indicating that Petitioner properly served Respondent with notice of the request.

FL-24-00235 Ramirez Cabrera, Omar vs. Serna, Victoria

The Court continues the hearing on Child and Spousal Support to Thursday, December 1, 2025, at 1:30 p.m. in Department 2 due to the Department of Child Support Services' involvement in the case.

In light of the memo submitted by the investigator, the Court shall appoint a new investigator to conduct the Level 2 Investigation and continue the review hearing to December 3, 2025 at 8:30 a.m.

FL-25-00123 Cedillo Vargas, Ulises vs. Penaloza, Sonia

The hearing on Petitioner's Request for Order is continued to October 8, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. to allow for the related Petitions regarding guardianship to be heard.

Respondent has not provided sufficient facts that would justify an order permitting Respondent to have exclusive use of the property. There are no minor children involved in this matter and there are no allegations of domestic violence that would justify such an order. (See Family Code §6321.)
